Bids are requested for supplying and the installation of plant material for the finish landscaping of the Dwight Foster Library located on Merchant Street in the City of Fort Atkinson.

Bids are being solicited from contractors for material and installation of the following:

As part of this bid, the contractor shall provide all stated plants in healthy condition and in the planting size as requested, unless otherwise agreed upon by owner. The plants will be placed in the locations as shown on said planting plan. All plant material, other than trees, will be located within a previously placed fabric and granite mulched space within 4 feet of the building. After placing plants in the area adjacent to the building, the mulched area shall be returned to its original condition. The trees will be placed in the lawn of the site and prior to installation; existing sod shall be removed in a circle, having a 4 foot radius around the location of the tree. Contractor will take precautions when planting trees not to adversely disrupt the grass areas with wheel ruts or other damage made by machines used to plant said trees. The contractor will remove any backfill material that is not used in the planting process and shall leave the lawn area in the same condition as found. The contractor shall stake and secure planted trees with metal fence posts that will be provided by the owner. The owner will be responsible for removal of said posts in the future.
