



SPECIAL SERVICES POLICY

1. The Dwight Foster Public Library shall provide special services to the community whenever feasible, providing they do not conflict with normal library operation. These might be meeting rooms, special collections, exhibits, book talks, audio-visual aids, book lists, story hours, etc. The librarian shall use their discretion in the use of the building, according to library room policy.
2. The Library Board recognizes that no single library can meet all demands in its community. Libraries in different political subdivisions working together, sharing their services and resources, can meet more nearly the full needs of their users.
3. The library Board and the librarian will be alert to opportunities of cooperation with other libraries, to strengthen the services and resources of the library.
4. The Library Board and the librarian will make use of the consultants of the Department Public Instruction, Division for Library Services whenever there is a need and to support the work of the Division in the state system.
6. The Friends of the Library, a voluntary non-profit organization, was organized in October 1979, to provide support services to the library and the Library Board. The Friends develop volunteer services, bring informative programs to the community, aid in providing funds for special library needs, and help with other special activities, as needed by the Library Staff and Board.
